Bikes and scooters



Thank you for your support in **not allowing school-aged children** to ride their bikes and scooters on the school site. This is for the health and safety of everyone. We do have people on site using crutches and walking sticks and this can make them feel nervous. We have also had some near misses when children have come off their bikes on the ramps and some occasions where they have ridden quickly towards the main road.

Earrings and Jewellery

Small plain studs only please to be worn in ear lobes (not helix). **Earrings must not be worn on PE days.** No other jewellery, apart from a watch, should be worn. This is because these items could easily catch on something in school and cause injury to your child or another child.



Uniform Reminders

Please ensure your child wears black shoes - apart from on PE days. Also the correct PE kit: plain white Tshirt (not cropped please), black or navy shorts/joggers and a plain navy or black hoody. This is to ensure that the children do not feel pressured to wear expensive logos and badges during this time of financial hardship and that they still look smart on PE days. 


Breakfast Club – Important Health & Safety
